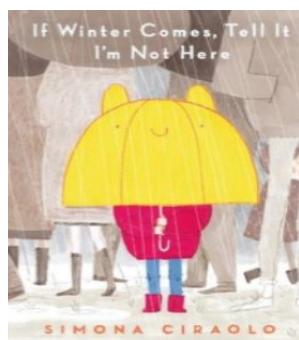
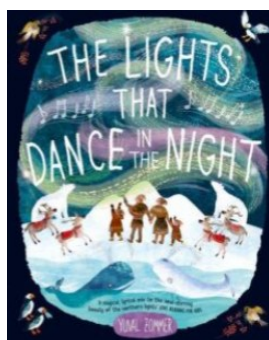
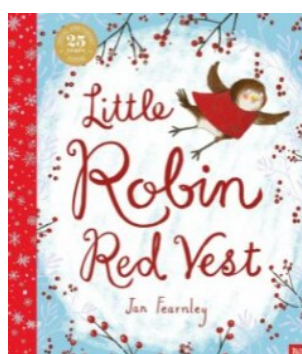
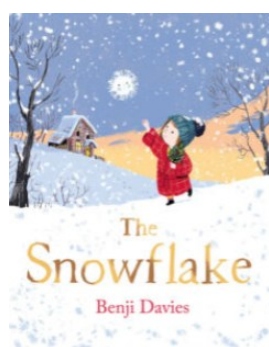
Reading Ambassadors – 2025 / 26
