This term we are learning ...

In **Understanding of the World** we are going to be focusing on **All About Me** learning about body parts, our features and their purposes – for example we see with our eyes. We are also going to be exploring **Autumn objects** and watching as the leaves change.

We are going to be thinking about things we can do now that we couldn't do as babies and beginning to learn about yesterday and tomorrow.

We are also going to be talking about and asking questions about the place we live and the places we have visited.

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In other subjects...

In Expressive Arts and Designs we are going to be investigating the construction areas and beginning to use tools such as scissors and glue spreaders.

We are going to look at the artists Victor Pasmore and Jackson Pollock making face collages and printing and creating our very own messy monster.

We are going to be learning new songs and experimenting with percussion instruments.

In Physical Development we are going to be learning about moving around our outdoor space safely and stopping with control. We are also going to learn to play as a group

Maths this term

In Maths we are going to be comparing quantities using the terms, 'more than, fewer than and same' without counting.

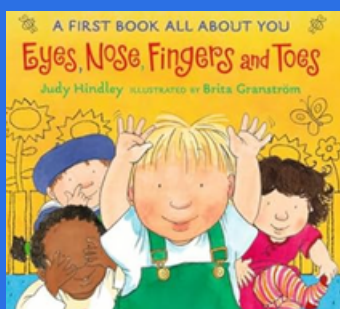
We are also going to be exploring shapes and patterns.
